GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION ON THE BASIS OF SPORTS IN POST GRADUATE PROGRAMME 2018

An applicant seeking admission to the Postgraduate programme on the basis of Sports Quota must appear in Entrance Test to be conducted by the respective Department. The applicant must fulfill the minimum eligibility criterion of the programme of the concerned Department. The other guidelines regarding the admission are as follows:

1. The Department shall communicate the total number of seats under Sports Quota (Supernumerary) for admission on the basis of Sports to the Delhi University Sports Council (DUSC).
2. The schedule of verification of Merit/Participation Sports Certificate and Sports Trials will be notified to all the Departments by the DUSC.
3. The Department shall send the Application Forms along with the self-attested copies of Merit/Participation Sports Certificate of the applicants who have applied for admission on the basis of Sports by the date communicated to them by the DUSC.
4. The Sports Admission Committee of the DUSC shall screen the Application Forms, verify the original Merit/Participation Sports Certificate, allot Marks as per the criteria for Marking of Merit/Participation Sports Certificate, conduct Sports Trials and recommend admission on the basis of Sports to the concerned Department.
5. The admission to the Sports Quota (Supernumerary) will be only on the basis of Entrance Examination and shall be finalized by the concerned Department i.e. Marks obtained in Merit/Participation Sports Certificate and Sports Trials be added to the Marks obtained in Entrance Examination of the concerned Department. The Department shall then prepare a Merit List for admission on the basis of Sports and make admissions accordingly.
6. The grievance related to allocation of marks for Merit/Participation Sports Certificate and Sports Trial shall be redressed by the PG Sports Grievance Committee of the DUSC.
7. The list (soft and hard copy) of finally admitted applicants on the basis of Sports shall be sent to DUSC by the Department within seven days from the last date of admission of the University.
8. The Department shall maintain proper record of the applicants admitted on the basis of Sports.
9. The applicant as per their age must be eligible to participate in Inter-University competitions for the next two years and should not be employed on Part-time /Full- time basis anywhere.
10. Any injury/ casualty caused to the applicant during Sports Trial shall be the sole responsibility of the applicant.
11. It is mandatory to submit an Undertaking on Non-Judicial Stamp paper of Rs. 100/- by the applicant at the time of admission to the DUSC stating that the applicant will play for College/ Department and University during their Post-Graduate programme of study. The Department must ensure that the applicant submits the Undertaking to the DUSC before being finally admitted by the Department.

I. Super Category : Direct Admission without Sports Trial

(Category A of the Criteria for Marking of Merit/Participation Sports Certificate)

Sportspersons who have represented India in the under-mentioned Competition(s), recognized and funded by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (MYAS) will be given Direct Admission without Sports Trial.

1. Olympic Games by the International Olympic Committee (IOC)
2. World Championship / World Cup by International Sports Federations (ISFs)
3. Commonwealth Games by Commonwealth Games Federation (CGF)
4. Asian Games by Olympic Council of Asia (OCA)
5. Asian Championships by International Sports Federations (ISFs)
6. South Asian Federation (SAF) Games by South Asian Sports Council (SASC)
7. Paralympic Games by International Paralympic Committee (IPC)

II. Direct Admission without Sports Trial

(Category B1 of the Criteria for Marking of Merit/Participation Sports Certificate)

Sportspersons who have achieved 1st Position with participation in all three years in All India Inter University Competition organized by Association of Indian Universities (AIU) will be given Direct Admission without Sports Trial.

III. Admission on the Basis of Sports Trial

(Categories B2 & C of the Criteria for Marking of Merit/ Participation Sports Certificate)

A. Maximum 75 Marks for Merit/Participation Sports Certificate

1. Criteria for Marking of Merit/Participation Sports Certificate displays the Marks for different levels of Game/Sport Competitions.
2. Sports Certificate of Invitational / Memorial / Open / Prize Money League / Ranking Competitions will not be considered.
3. Applicants are required to take the print out of the submitted online Registration Form and submit it to the concerned Department alongwith the Self Attested copies of the Merit/Participation Sports Certificate.
4. Only the Highest Merit/ Participation Sports Certificate will be considered for Marking. In case for availing Bonus Marks as per the Criteria for Marking, documentary evidence may be produced.
5. Merit/Participation Sports Certificate of preceding three years will be considered from 01st May 2015 to 30th April 2018.
6. Level of competency of the applicant will be determined only for those who have achieved distinction only during the preceding three years in those Games/ Sport recognized by AIU / MYAS in which Inter-University Competitions are held.

B. Maximum 25 Marks for Sports Trial

Sports Trial includes Game/ Sport Specific Fitness, Fundamental Skills and Overall Playing Ability.

1. The applicant should go through the notifications issued by the DUSC/DU Website.
2. The DUSC shall video-graph the Sports Trial and preserves the recording.
3. The applicant must secure minimum 13 marks in the Sports Trial to be eligible for admission on the basis of Sports.
